Subject: Admission of Foreign Students in the MBBS and BDS courses in the Government and Non-Government medical colleges/dental colleges/units/institutes in Bangladesh for 2013-2014 academic year under self-finance scheme.

Government of Bangladesh has offered a number of seats in the MBBS and BDS Courses at the Government and Non-Government Medical Colleges/Dental Colleges/Units/Institutes for foreign students under self-finance scheme.

The criteria, procedures for admission, and application form are attached.


A total number of 107 seats is made available for the foreign students for the academic session 2013-2014. Out of them, 54 (fifty four) seats of MBBS course and 03(three) seats of BDS course will remain earmarked for the applicants of the SAARC Member States. Interested candidates from the countries other than SAARC region will be able to apply for the remaining 45 (forty five) seats of MBBS course and 05 (five) seats of BDS course earmarked for them.

If number of eligible candidates exceed the quota earmarked for the non-SAARC category, selection of candidates will be made according to merit, determined on the basis of marks/grades obtained by the candidate at the SSC and HSC examination (or equivalent examinations) as per the criteria enclosed herewith.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Government of Bangladesh will accept applications submitted through (i) Bangladesh Missions abroad, and (ii) Foreign Mission in Bangladesh. The address details of Embassy of Bangladesh:
