
Today is 16th December, the great victory day. On this day in 1971, we attained our much-awaited victory through a bloody nine month liberation war. On this auspicious occasion, I extend my sincere greetings and warm felicitations to all the citizens of Bangladesh living in both home and abroad.

On this happy moment of victory, I recall with profound respect the greatest Bengali of all times, the great architect of our independence, Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman. His charismatic leadership contributed to the emergence of Bangladesh as an independent and sovereign state in the world. I pay my profound homage to the three million martyrs and two hundred thousand mothers and sisters whose supreme sacrifice and honor gave us a new identity. I salute to all the freedom fighters including all the war victims. I express my sincere gratitude to all friendly countries, foreign friends, expatriate nationals and members of the diplomatic corps whose support during the liberation war accelerated our victory.

Under the visionary, courageous and charismatic leadership of the Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, the Bangalies achieved their own nation-state, flag and national anthem. In November, the country achieved record \$5 billion export earnings in a single month for the first time. The inflow of foreign remittance has also increased and new record has been set on agricultural production.

I convey my special gratitude and congratulations to those who have actively participated in this great achievements from their respective positions at home and abroad under the dynamic leadership of Sheikh Hasina. Let us pledge on this day of victory, we will work together with the spirit of the great liberation war and implement the vision of 'Sonar Bangla' under the able leadership of Hon'ble Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina.
