Historic 7th March observed in Colombo

Today, Bangladesh High Commission in Colombo observed the historic 7th March in a befitting manner. The day's program began with the ceremonial hoisting of the national flag at the Chancery in the morning. The High Commission officials placed a floral wreath at the portrait of the Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman. A special prayer was offered for the eternal peace of the Father of the Nation and his martyred family members as well as the continued peace and prosperity of Bangladesh under the able leadership of Hon'ble Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina.

The High Commission hosted a discussion session on the occasion.
