“Hasina: A Daughter’s Tale” screened in Greece

Athens, 03 July 2022: The Embassy of Bangladesh, in cooperation with the first multilingual library in Greece “We Need Books”, successfully organized a screening of the documentary film **“Hasina: A Daughter’s Tale”**. Held at the library premises in the evening of 3 July 2022 the screening was attended by a good number of Bangladeshi community people, students, Embassy officials, members of the diplomatic corps and the local civil society.

The maiden screening of the docu-film in a country like Greece, known as the cradle of ancient and western civilization, created a lot of enthusiasm and curiosity among the audience about Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, her extended family members and their role in the making of a modern, democratic and secular developing nation.
