Bangladesh Consulate General in Toronto organized a two-day consular camp at the Saskatoon City of Saskatchewan on 4-5 May 2024. Over 200 expatriate Bangladeshis working, studying and living in and around the province of Saskatchewan received different consular services including new e-Passports, MRP re-issue, No Visa Required (NVR), Attestation, Power of Attorney (POA), etc from the camp. A large number of Bangladeshi diaspora came to the camp to learn how they could get various consular services from the Consulate.

Members of the Consulate's consular team including the Consul General Mr. Md. Faruk Hossain patiently listened to all the queries raised by Bangladesh community members and offered responses and solutions. The Consul General also addressed the Bangladeshi students at the University of Saskatchewan on 05 May 2024.

Overall, it was a successful consular camp. The Consulate expresses its heartfelt thanks to the members of the Bangladeshi Community in Saskatchewan and the Bangladeshi Association of Saskatchewan for their support in successfully organizing the consular camp.

It was the first time the Bangladesh Consulate General in Toronto organized a consular camp outside the provinces of Ontario. In the future, the Consulate will organize similar camps in the provinces of Alberta, British Columbia, Manitoba, and other places that are under the consular jurisdiction of the Consulate.
