



**Profile of
H.E. Mr. M Amanul Haq
Ambassador of Bangladesh in Ankara, Türkiye**

Ambassador M Amanul Haq is a career foreign service officer belonging to the 18th batch of Bangladesh Civil Service (BCS)-Foreign Affairs cadre.

He served as the Chief of Protocol at the Ministry, a position he has been holding since 2020 upto 18 February 2023.

Joining the service in 1999, he served the government in various capacities both home and abroad.

He started his diplomatic career as Consul and Deputy Head of Mission at the Bangladesh Consulate General in New York.

Later on, he joined the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) Headquarters in Jeddah, K.S.A on secondment where, after a significant stint, he eventually rose to the position of acting Director General of the Cabinet and Advisor to the Secretary General.

Upon return, he assumed the position of Director General for West Asia region. He also served as Director General for International Organization, Bangabandhu Birth Centenary and Golden Jubilee of Bangladesh's Independence Celebration Cell and Corona Cell before becoming the Chief of Protocol of Bangladesh.

He obtained his Honours and Masters Degree in International Relations from Dhaka University and got a Diploma in International Relations from L'Ecole Nationale d'Administration, France. He completed several courses on International Law, Peace, Security and conflict resolution in the Netherlands, Norway and Switzerland.

He is married and blessed with two daughters.
