MBBS/BDS Admission Circular for Foreign Students (Session 2023-2024)

01. Please be informed that the Directorate General of Medical Education under Medical Education & Family Welfare division of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Bangladesh has announced admission of foreign students in Government Medical and Dental Colleges for the academic year 2023-2024. Total 221 seats are allocated for the foreign students this year. Among these 117 seats are allocated for SAARC countries, 99 seats are allocated for Non-SAARC countries and 5 reserved seats, under Bangladesh Government's scholarship program. Country-wise allocation of seats are as follows:

In addition to admission in Government Medical/Dental Colleges, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare will consider application of foreign students for admission in Private Medical Colleges/Dental Colleges/Dental Units in Bangladesh. List of Government and Private Medical Colleges & Dental Colleges/Dental units and availability of seats are enclosed at Annexure 'A' and 'B' respectively. For Private Medical College maximum number of foreign student are 45% of their total allocated seats.
03. Criteria and procedure of application for foreign students are enclosed at Annexure 'C' & 'D'.
04. Interested candidates have to submit an online application from 05.01.2024 only through <http://foreignstudents.dgme.gov.bd/login>, website: www.dgme.gov.bd. **No hard copy of application will be needed to submit to Bangladesh foreign mission abroad.** Deadline of submission of online application is 29 February, 2024 for both Government and Private Medical Colleges/Dental Colleges/Dental Units. No application will be considered after the deadline.
05. Candidates have to upload recent Passport Size Photograph, Passport, all academic documents (certificate and marks sheet of O' level/10 class completion equivalent examination and A' level/12 class completion equivalent examination) and copy of Telegraphic Transfer (T.T)/SWIFT Message of USD 100\$ (One Hundred US Dollar) in specific template of each online application. All submitted academic documents required to be attested by Ministry of Education and Ministry of Foreign affairs of the respective countries. After submission of online application through online platform, candidates have to collect a system generated printed copy of the application form. Eligible applicant must submit the attested document to Bangladesh mission to obtain visa.

Criteria for Admission of Foreign Students in the MBBS and BDS Courses in Government Medical Colleges/Dental Colleges / Dental Units in Bangladesh for 2023-2024 academic year.

- A) Equivalence of Foreign Degree:
- Must have passed qualifying examination of A' level or equivalent examination.
 - O' level or equivalent examination passed not before 2020.
 - A' level or equivalent examination passed not before 2022.
 - A' level or equivalent exam must be completed within 2 years of O' level or equivalent exam.
 - Minimum aggregate GPA in O' level or equivalent and A' level or equivalent examination: 8.00 (eight)
 - Minimum GP in Biology: 3.50 out of 5.0 scale in A' level or equivalent exam.
 - For calculating GPA against the percentage of marks obtained in O' level or other equivalent exam only top 5 subjects are considered.
- B) For calculation of GPA against the marks obtained in A' level or equivalent exam, only 3 subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) are considered.
- Application Form: Duly filled online application forms in specific template and upload the stated above by 29 February, 2024.
 - All certificates must be duly attested by the competent authority, i.e. Education and the Foreign Ministries of the respective countries. Applicants need not require to submit the hard copies of relevant documents to the Embassy/High Commission.
 - Eligible applicants have to produce all academic certificates, admit cards and mark-sheets/ transcripts in original at the time of their admission.
- C) Tuition Fees: For Government medical and dental colleges, students from SAARC countries will require to pay tuition and other fees at the rate charged to a Bangladeshi student. Students from other countries will have to pay \$5000 (five thousand) per year in addition to the tuition fees charged for Bangladeshi student. If students can't pass in the exam in due time additional charges have to pay.
- D) Each applicant must send USS 100.00 (One Hundred) as non-refundable equivalence fee by Telegraphic Transfer (T. T)/SWIFT Code through




