Mr. Faiyaz Murshid Kazi has been appointed as the next Ambassador of Bangladesh to the Kingdom of Thailand. He is expected to serve as the Permanent Representative of Bangladesh to the UN Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UN-ESCAP).
